- 13/12 bridges (complete)
- 4 strings per course
- Plain top and 4 sound holes with wooden rings
- Stand and four feet
- Tuning key
- Original case, bearing maker's name (+ modern stickers)
- Split in soundboard (stable)
- Made by John Harwood, Great Yarmouth (fully researched see <u>www.eastangliandulcimers.org.uk</u> for details)
- Likely home key: C
- £350



No. 9 - a small dulcimer in good condition, with case

- 9/8 bridges (1 loose)
- 3 strings per course (2 missing)
- Stand and two stud feet
- Plain top and 2 sound holes with metal inserts
- Original case
- Tuning key
- Split in soundboard (stable)
- Unknown maker, bought in north Norfolk and similar to Mollie
 Whitaker's dulcimer (for Mollie, see www.eastangliandulcimers.org.uk)
- Likely home key: D

No.17 - a large dulcimer, very nice, will make a lovely instrument

- 10/11 bridges (complete)
- 5 strings per course (some missing, mostly bass strings)
- Leather waist strap
- Tuning key
- Stand and four feet
- Black top with gilt decoration and four sound holes with wooden rings
- Old woodworm holes- stabilised
- No case
- Nothing known of its history
- Likely home key: G
- Top will benefit from a bit of gentle cleaning to reveal the decoration
